

Instructions for those without relatives who are members:

1. Submit an online Preliminary Lineage Review request to the General Society on their web site:

The General Society reviewers will cc the state Historian when they reply to you. **(Note: you are required to bring any previously approved applications recommended by the General Society reviewers to modern Mayflower Society standards.)**

2. After receiving that reply the Arizona Membership Chair will contact you to find out how much documentation you still need to obtain in order to complete the process.

3. The Membership Chair will then either refer you to the Resources Section of our web site or send you the Arizona New Member Preliminary Application form immediately. You must be reasonably within 6 months of completing the process for the Membership Chair to send you the Preliminary Application.

4. Upon receipt of the completed Arizona New Member Preliminary Application form and a check for \$5, payable to the Arizona Mayflower Society, the Membership Chair will mail you the actual application form with instructions.

5. Submit the completed full application form and any requested documentation to the Arizona Historian. Electronic submission is strongly preferred.

Disclaimer: Both the Arizona Mayflower Society and the General Society in Plymouth are run by a very small number of volunteers. Neither can be anyone's personal genealogist. Our Resources section can link you to clubs, libraries, and private genealogists where you may be able to find any help you need. Be aware that the standards of proof required by the General Society are more rigorous than that of any other lineage society and there are no exceptions to these standards. Your documentation will be incorporated into future reference books and future applicants may be working from your approved application. Do not submit applications from other societies, as they are not accepted, and do not submit anything not requested by the Historian. Doing so will only slow the review of your application.
