

Instructions for people with a relative already a member:

If your relative joined or is a member in another state (and you do not already have a copy of his/her application):

1. Purchase a copy by sending a request and check or money order for \$10 to: General Society of Mayflower Descendants, P.O. Box 3297, Plymouth, MA 02361.

OR

If she or he was or is a member in Arizona, the Arizona Historian already has a copy and you do not need to send for it.

Note: You are required to bring previously approved applications to modern Mayflower Society documentation standards.

2. Contact the Arizona Membership Chair (Membership@ArizonaMayflowerSociety.org) . (If you already have your relative's approved application, contact the Membership Chair right away.)
3. Depending on how much documentation is still required, the Membership Chair will refer you to the Resources Section of our web site or send you the Arizona New Member Preliminary Application form. You must be reasonably within 6 months of completing the process for the Membership Chair to send you the Preliminary Application.
4. Upon receipt of the completed Preliminary Application form and a check for \$5 (payable to: Arizona Mayflower Society), the Membership Chair will send you a full application packet with instructions.
5. Submit the completed full application form and any requested documentation to the Arizona Historian. Electronic submission is strongly preferred.

Disclaimer: Both the Arizona Mayflower Society and the General Society in Plymouth are run by a very small number of volunteers. Neither can be anyone's personal genealogist. Our Resources section can link you to clubs, libraries, and private genealogists where you may be able to find any help you need. Be aware that the standards of proof required by the General Society are more rigorous than that

of any other lineage society and there are no exceptions to these standards. Your documentation will be incorporated into future reference books and future applicants may be working from your approved application. Do not submit applications from other societies, as they are not accepted, and do not submit anything not requested by the Historian. Doing so will only slow the review of your application.
